

#### UGC Expert Team visited Abhilashi University on December 7 -8, 2015

A 15 members team of experts constituted by University Grants Commission, New Delhi for the inspection of infrastructure, faculty, courses and financial viability etc. of Abhilashi University visited the University on 7 -8 December, 2015. Team was headed by Prof. G.D. Yadav, Vice-Chancellor, ICT Bombay. They arrived at the campus on 07/12/2015 at 10:00 AM. All the team members were received by the Hon'ble Chancellor Dr. R.K. Abhilashi, Pro-Chancellor Er. L.K. Abhilashi, Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.S. Banyal, Registrar, Dean of Studies and Deans of various Faculties, Controller of Examinations & Finance Officer of the University. The meeting started in the conference hall of the University. Hon'ble Chancellor welcomed the experts by presenting Himachali caps and shawls. After introduction of members and University officials, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.S. Banyal made the power point presentation about the university. He gave a complete overview of Abhilashi University. He informed the members about the Act of University, students, faculty, courses, infrastructure and examination system of the university. The Chairman and other members of the committee sought many detailed information about the affairs of the university. Thereafter, sub-committees were constituted to inspect various faculties. The members of sub-committees were introduced with the faculty member by the respective Deans who also made presentation about the progress of the faculty. The members visited the classrooms and laboratories and interacted with the students of the faculty. Chairman, Prof. Yadav also visited different departments. hostels and other common facilities of the university. After lunch the students of Ayurveda faculty presented a cultural programme for the committee. Thereafter, the committee members had separate meetings with the students of the university followed by meeting with teaching

### **Students Participation in Field Operations**

The students are given practical field training. Here in the pictures given below, they are busy in filling the flower pots after preparing a mixture of soil, sand and well decomposed farm yard manure. The students then fill the pot after checking the drainage hole at the bottom and laying the first 5 cm layer of gravels so as to ensure proper drainage of excess water. Each student then plants a flowering plant and undertakes to take care of that. The students did earthing up of fruit basins, removed the weeds from the uncultivated area as well and used them as mulch in the basins.

### Registration and Commencement of Teaching in Academic Session 2015-16

Abhilashi University opened on 01-02-2016 after the winter vacation w.e.f 25-12-2015 to 31-01-2016. The students appeared enthusiastic about the new courses to be undertaken during the semester.Registrations of the students were made and classes began from 02-02-2016. University followed its academic calendar and all activities were carried as per the schedule after the completion of mandatory requirement of teaching days. 1<sup>st</sup> mid term examinations were held from 28-03-2016 to 30-03-2016. Similarly, 2<sup>nd</sup> mid term examination of the students under various courses is scheduled to be held from 23-05-2016 to 26-05-2016. It would follow final/end-term examination of practical and theory from 30<sup>th</sup> May to 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2016, and 06-06-2016 to 25-06-2016, respectively. Therefore, the results would be expected by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2016. Thereafter, Abhilashi University would allow summer break of 20 days (01-07-2016 to 20-07-2016). However, end examination of BAMS students under annual system would be held in August-September 2016.
