He also distributed warm clothes and fruits to all the residents. He donated a cheque of Rs. 25000/- to the Home.



Medical Health Camps Organized and Health Check-Up in Selected Villages by the Team of Doctors of Abhilashi Ayurveda College and Research Institute of Abhilashi University:



Team of Doctors and supporting staff from Abhilashi Ayurveda College and Research Institute of Abhilashi University visited Four villages namely Naugraun, Chail Chowk, Ganaee, and Darri in Gohar Tehsil of Mandi District in Himachal Pradesh for health check-up & treatment of villagers on 06-02-2017, 14-02-2017, 25-02-2017, and 27-02-2017, respectively. Of the patients examined and diagnosed by the team, sixty of them suffered from Vat Rog and other diseases. All the households in these villages were also educated and advised to lead a hygienic and healthy quality of life. Doctors also identified variety of diseases and the patients with chronic health problems who were advised to contact them for further treatment at Abhilashi Ayurvedic Hospital at the university campus.



Another team of doctors supporting staff of Abhilashi University led by Dr. Baldev Singh conducted a medical health camp on 07-02-2017 at village Maggroo, Tehsil Gohar in Mandi District. The team examined patients and advised them to take precautionary measures about various ailments. They also distributed medicines free of cost to all the patients.



Team of Doctors and supporting staff from Abhilashi Ayurveda College and Research Institute of Abhilashi University visited Five villages namely Taruar, Bassa, Segali, Mandoglu, and Nehra in Gohar Tehsil of Mandi District in Himachal Pradesh for health Check-Up & treatments on 02-03-2017, 08-03-2017, 15-03-2017, 21-03-2017, and 25-03-2017, respectively. In its first round of health diagnoses in these villages, the team of Doctors was led by Dr. Baldev Singh. Other team members include Dr. Ved Parkash. Dr. Vandana, Dr. Vikash Rana, Dr. Rahul, Dr. Latika, Dr. Sunena, Pharmacist Anita, Nurse Jyoti with other supporting staff of Abhilashi University. In this, the team diagnosed all households & villagers. Out of these, the number of houses visited was sixty (60). The number of patients in these households was suffering from Vat Rog and other diseases. All the members of households in these villages were also educated and advised to lead quality life. Doctors also identified variety of diseases and the patients with chronic health problems who were advised to contact the Doctors for further treatment at Abhilashi Hospital Chail-Chowk.



Yet another Medical Health Camps were organized on 29-03-2017 in Chachyot Panchyat Bhawan at Tehsil Chaichiot by a team of Doctors namely Dr. Chetan , Dr. Latika, Dr. Vandna, Dr. Abhinav and other supporting staff members under the leadership of Dr. Baldev Singh, SMO, Abhilashi Ayurveda Hospital and Research Institute of Abhilashi University. These doctors diagnosed 58 patients and extended related treatment & relevant advice to keep good health. They also educated the patients to derive help from the available medical facilities at Abhilashi University.
