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
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

Campus Placement Drive/ Interview:

School of Pharmacy Abhilashi University, Chail- Chowk, Mandi organized placement drive on dated 03 March 2019. Mr. Abhishek Soni (Asst Prof Cum Placement officer) coordinates for the placement drive.

Mr. Baldev Thakur GM-HR gave presentation on company introduction. He discussed about production department i.e. the production department is responsible for converting raw materials and other inputs into finished goods or services. In between the processes of production, the department works to improve the efficiency of the production or assembly line so that it can meet the output targets set by company management and ensures finished products offer consumers the best value and quality.



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The main role of production is to turn inputs (raw materials) into outputs (finished goods). Outputs refer to a finished product or service and inputs are the materials that are needed to manufacture certain goods. When a business completes this process they are able to achieve customer satisfaction by producing products that are ready to be used and fit for purpose. The production department is responsible for ensuring quality is achieved in each item produced. They will need to carry out inspections and implement suitable quality initiatives. This is one of the major duties of this department because if mistakes are made on products, customer satisfaction will be decreased or if products are ruined during the production process it means that the company will have to throw "bad" products away (creating waste). Both aspects will lead the company to a loss of profit. Quality assurance is a good practice in the manufacture of pharmaceutical products, as it is the process of vouching for integrity of products to meet the standard for the proposed use. This may be helpful to appreciate the role of quality assurance as including preparation of data for the Qualified Person for the purpose of batch release and certification. In this case, the quality assurance organization would then take up the task of generating portions of batch-related data to ensure they are available through appropriate reporting systems as well as parallel so as to guarantee the functionality of standard quality systems. This department is responsibility for to establish the quality system, audit compliance to the quality system, procedures, specifications, manufacturing controls, describe responsibilities in writing, to remain independent etc.He discussed about research and development department. It refers to innovative activities undertaken by corporations or governments in developing new services or products, or improving existing services or products. Research and development constitutes the first stage of development of a potential new service or the production process. R&D activities must be closely coordinated with the organisation's marketing activities to ensure that the organisation is providing exactly what its customers want in the most efficient, effective and economical way. He also said that, Macleods offers dispersible, bi-layered, coated, uncoated, and enteric coated tablets; hard and soft gelatin capsules; dry powder injections and syrups; and granules and liquid orals.

The company provides products in various therapeutic groups, such as anti-infective, cardiovascular, CNS, respiratory inhalation, dermatology, oncology, and orthopedics; and anti-TB, asthma and COPD, anti bacterial, NSAIDS, malaria, HIV, antiarthritic, anti-osteoporotic, gastroenterology, gynecology, diabetology, and CVS. In order to commemorate the discovery of the Raman Effect in India by the Indian physicist, Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman in the year 1930, the day is celebrated as National Science Day. For his great success in the field of science in India, Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman had been awarded and honored with the Nobel Prize in the Physics in the year 1930. To honor this event, 28th of February is observed as a National Science Day in India by the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC). A particular theme is selected for every year National Science Day Celebration. The theme of this year was "Science for the People and the People for Science". National Science Day was celebrated at Abhilashi University, Chail Chowk Mandi (HP) on 28th February 2019. The session was open by lighting of lamps followed by respected Dean School of Pharmacy Dr. Amit

Dr. Amit Chaudhary, Dean School of Pharmacy in his welcome address briefed the gathering about the objectives of celebrating National Science Day. He discussed how the contribution of Science for the People and the People for Science in our day-to-day activities and made our life much easier.

On this occasion, a motivational and inspirational talk was delivered by the eminent speakers Mr. Abhishek Soni (Asst. Prof.) from Abhilashi University, Chail Chowk Mandi (HP).

The overall progress was recorded by the team leader Dr. Baldev Singh. Ayurveda Hospital and Research Institute of Abhilashi University.


