### Terms and conditions for running the courses:

Running of the existing as well as new courses is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The approval for courses is on the specific condition that faculty and physical academic infrastructure must be in place by May 30, 2021 to be confirmed by the University to the Commission followed by verification by the HPPERC failing which the approval of courses where faculty and infrastructure will be found deficient shall be deemed as withdrawn and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 2. The University shall indicate the following in its prospectus for the information of the students, general public and State Govt.:
  - a. Names and academic bio-data of faculty available for each course.
  - b. Physical academic infrastructure must find mention in the prospectus.



- c. Course wise seats approved indicating the seats reserved for the scheduled caste/scheduled tribe/ physically handicapped and Himachali candidates.
- d. Seats wherein available under lateral entry be mentioned specifically.
- e. Approved fee structure for each course.
- f. Scholarship scheme(s), if any.
- g. Duration of each course and course structure.
- h. Admission criteria for each course.
- i. HP-PERC introductory notice.

The university shall be required to supply a copy of the Prospectus to the Commission/State Govt. before it starts issuing the same for the academic session 2021-22. The above information should also be up-loaded on the website of the University indicating the details of faculty along with their photos and bio-data. The information regarding admission disclosure, examinations schedule, students passed out, faculty and academic infrastructure etc must be furnished from time to time to the Regulatory Commission in the manner as required.

- 3. Any approval, if required from any Central/ State Regulatory body/ Centre/ State Govt. as indicated in the remarks mentioned above or otherwise required, be provided to this Commission latest by May 30, 2021 failing which the courses and programmes requiring such permissions shall be deemed as withdrawn.
- 4. In case the University is of the opinion that it is unable to run any course due to deficient faculty or otherwise but not in violation of the rules and regulations pertaining to previous years granted courses, the same shall be intimated to the Commission by May 30, 2021. Course(s) once started shall have to be run for at least three years continuously and the university shall ensure the availability of full faculty strength and physical academic infrastructure as per approved intake as per norms for the course(s).
- 5. The eligibility and admission criteria for admission to the above courses shall be as prescribed by the concerned Regulatory Bodies and the State Government. Admission through migration mode in the first year not meeting the eligibility criteria shall be treated as invalid and subject to penal action as per HPPERC Rules, 2011.
- 6. Admission of foreign students be regulated as per AICTE Notification No.F.37-3/Legal/2004 dated 21.01.2004 circulated to All State Private Universities vide Commission letter No. HPPERC/55/General Complaints/2012-704 to 719 dated 07.08.2014 and subsequent orders issued in this regard.
- 7. Admission on the basis of test conducted by H-PUMA shall not be allowed at all.
- 8. AICTE guidelines regarding admission under lateral entry be followed in letter and spirit.
- 9. Where University has dropped / closed programme / proposed zero-intake / break in Extension of approval be obtained for closure of the programme from AICTE in terms of Section 1.6 of the Approval Process Hand Book 2018-19 or as directed in the latest edition of the Approval Process Hand Book.

- 10. UGC guidelines regarding providing 3 % reservation in all courses to the persons with disabilities circulated vide this office letter No. HPPERC/73/Notification/2012-952 to 967 dated 08.09.2014 be also followed meticulously.
- 11. Any admissions, made in violation of the prescribed norms shall be invalid and will attract provisions contained in HP-PERC Act, 2010 and Rules framed thereunder. The inference of this may also be incorporated in the Prospectus of the University so as to avoid any complication at a later stage.
- 12. The University to get fee approved from the State Government including hostel charges, convocation participation charges, and fee to be charged for in absentia degree etc. as per statutory requirements. A copy of such proposal should invariably be sent to the Commission.
- 13. The University shall comply with "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Education Institutions" Regulations, 2012.
- 14. In case of Research Degree (Masters and Doctoral) Programmes roster for allotment of students to supervisor must be followed and number be adhered to as per UGC guidelines.
- 15. The University shall strictly comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 and engage faculty as per the norms fixed by the regulatory bodies viz. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI, PCI, NCI, CCIM, AYUSH etc. The University shall observe all the standards of instructions and prescribed norms for the running of a course/programme/ grant of degree which shall be imparted by a duly qualified teaching staff and appropriate academic physical infrastructure facilities as prescribed.
- 16. The University shall ensure submission of requisite information to the UGC as required under Sections 3.7 & 3.8 of U.G.C. (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 which inter-alia requires sending of intimation to the U.G.C, six months prior to starting of a new course. Where the U.G.C. inspection is overdue, the University shall ensure submission of requisite information to the U.G.C. in the prescribed format at the earliest so that inspection could take place.
- 17. If, any course(s)/ degree(s)/ programme(s) is being run or is/ are to be run by the University which has/ have not been approved by the UGC/ other regulatory bodies, the same shall be liable for cancellation without any notice and no future correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 18. If any information provided is found incorrect at any stage or the assurances provided regarding meeting the norms of faculty and infrastructure in respect of all approved courses is not fulfilled or in the event of violation of standards of admission, charging of excess fees than approved or indulging in practices which are not in conformity with the prescribed regulations, the Regulatory Commission reserves the right to withdraw the approval and take such action, as it may deem fit.
- 19. No student should be admitted on the condition that his/her fees will be deducted from scholarship amount granted under SC/ST category by govt. of HP. Any violation found in this regard will impose penal action on University.

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20. All the Government norms in all respects be followed in letter and spirit.

Grant of Conditional Permission to "Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Chail Chowk, Teh. Chachiot, Mandi-175008, Himachal Pradesh" for Sub: admission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2020-21 under section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970 in view of representation dated 06.03.2021 to consider the permission of the college in compliance of Order dated 01.03.2021, passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at Delhi in W.P. (C) 2110/2021 & connected matters - reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter with Ref.no. L-14014/368/2020 EP-1 dated 28.01.2021 vide which denial of permission was conveyed to the said college with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the A.Y. 2020-21.

- The reason for the college being not considered for total intake capacity of 60 UG seats for the A.Y 2020-21, as per Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulation, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made there under and as per approved Standard Operative procedures (SOPs) and policies, is due to the following deficiencies:
  - (i) Shortcoming of 01 higher faculty against the requirement of 01 in each of Kriya Sharira, Rasa Shastra & Bhaishjya Kalpana, Swasthavritta & Yoga, Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka and Kaumarbhritya- Balaroga as per RMS, 2016.
  - (ii) Shortcoming of 02 higher faculties against the requirement of 02 in Kayachikitsa as
  - (iii)Shortcoming of 01 lower faculty against the requirement of 01 in each of Rachana Sharira and Dravyaguna as per RMS, 2016.
- However, in view of representation of the Principal dated 06.03.2021 to consider their case in compliance of the order dated 01.03.2021 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at Delhi in W.P. (C) 2110/2021 & connected matters, wherein at para 11, the Hon'ble court has referred to the paragraph 3(a) of the Status Note, which the Hon'ble High Court has taken on record, is reproduced below as under:

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"The AYUSH Ministry will grant a conditional approval/permission for the academic year 2020-21 to those institutions which have continuously received permission from Ministry of AYUSH for the preceding 5 academic years, on the basis of the affidavits/ documents already submitted by them. The existing show cause notices and any consequent orders issued against such institutions will stand withdrawn, and no fresh show cause notices will be issued to such institutions"

Therefore, as detailed above, the college under reference has been examined in compliance of order dated 01.03.2021 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at Delhi on the basis of representation dated 06.03.2021 of the Principal, and is found eligible for grant of Conditional Permission for 60 seats in UG(BAMS) course for the A.Y. 2020-21 as the college has received permission from Ministry of AYUSH for the preceding 5 (five) academic years.

- 4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to "Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Chail Chowk, Teh. Chachiot, Mandi-175008, Himachal Pradesh" for conducting 60 seats in UG(BAMS) course for the academic session 2020-21 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, in compliance of Order dated 01.03.2021 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, subject to the following:
  - The fulfillment of conditions as specified in the Undertaking/Indemnity bond submitted by the college.
  - ii. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, nonteaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- 5. It is further informed that minimum of 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority of State/UT Government as designated by Central Government vide letter F.No.L.11011/02/2020-EP (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
- 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Board of Governors, CCIM and the Central Government.
- 8. As per clause 3(1)(a) of IMCC, MSR Regulations, 2016, the following requirements which are required to be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020, will be examined for considering the permission for the session 2021-22:
  - All the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

- (ii) All the Requirements of "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard of Educations in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda college); and
- (iii) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made there under should be fulfilled in toto.
- 9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2021-22.
- 10. The Ministry's letter of even no. dated 28.01.2021 stands withdrawn.
- 11. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.

### RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution had submitted application online on 29.05.2015 to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Teacher Education Course.

- 2. AND, WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution in compliance to the decision of clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time the Northern Regional Committee having satisfied itself that the institution fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and the extant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the proposed Teacher Education course, such as, instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the course and has selected/appointed qualified teaching staff as per norms duly approved by the affiliating body, decided to grant recognition to the institution in its 299th meeting held from 01st to 05th April, 2019 for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (Integrated) course.
- NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to the following institution for conducting Teacher Education programme with an annual intake mentioned against its name from the academic session 2020-2021 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below:

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017 which provides as under:-
  - An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency indentified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.
  - All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to go themselves accredited by the aforsiad accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regualtions.
  - The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.
- The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is (iv) always in position.
- (v)—The Norms-for-teaching-staff-in-respect-of-their-qualifications-and-experience-shall be as per-provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.
- Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution: -
  - (i) The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCT Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliation to the institution.
  - (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions shall gradually move towards becoming composite institutions.
  - (iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognitions granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.
- The institution shall submit a Self-Appraisal Report to the Regional Committee at the end of each 7. academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following: -
  - Copy of Application Form (i)
  - Land and Building Particulars (ii)
  - (iii) Staff Profile
  - Recognition Order (iv)

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- 9. In case, if the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the land is to be transferred within six months from the date of recognition order in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the Regional Committee along with new land documents within the stipulated time.
- The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted 10. MHRD.
- The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month from the date of issue of this order. 11.
- If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and 12. Regulations, the Regional Committee shall withdraw recognition under provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
- 13. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
